(1) Roll Call -

The Special City Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Bill Edwards at 6:00p.m. Those Present and answering roll call were Mayor Bill Edwards, Keith Higginbotham (via Zoom), Josie Reed (in Person) and Amy Rochette (via Zoom). Misty Elam (via Zoom), and Darren Warren (via Zoom) and Justin Cowgur was absent. Those present and not answering role call were City Attorney Brian Rabal (via Zoom), and Financial Director Carl Rabey.

(2) Ordinance -

- **Ordinance 2022-84 - AN ORDINANCE WAIVING BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2023 CHEVROLET TAHOE FROM SUPERIOR AUTOMOTIVE, SILOAM SPRINGS, ARKANSAS FOR THE CENTERTON POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

Mayor Edwards addressed the Council, stating that this Ordinance is to waive the bidding requirement for a 2023 Chevrolet for the Police Department, at a cost of \$47,142.00. He stated this was to replace a 2015 Chevrolet Tahoe with a major engine problem. A copy of the quote for the truck was contained in the Council's Dropbox packet.

Mayor Edwards asked the Council if there were any questions.

There were no questions.

Darren Warren made a motion to read the Ordinance by title only, with a 2nd from Josie Reed. All Council Members present voted in favor and the motion carried. City Attorney Brian Rabal read the Ordinance by title only. Keith Higginbotham made a motion to suspend the rule requiring the reading of the Ordinance on 3 separate occasions, with a 2nd from Misty Elam. All Council Members present voted

in favor and the motion carried. Keith Higginbotham made a motion to adopt the Ordinance with a 2nd from Josie Reed. All Council Members present voted in favor and the motion carried.

There was a discussion on the need for an Emergency Clause, City Attorney Brian Rabal stated it would be a good idea to add the emergency clause, unless the dealership would hold the vehicle for 30 days.

Keith Higginbotham made a motion to add the emergency clause, 2nd by Darren Warren, All Council Members present voted in favor and the motion carried. City Attorney Brian Rabal read the emergency clause. Keith Higginbotham made a motion to adopt the emergency clause, 2nd by Josie Reed. All Council Members present voted in favor and the motion carried.

Mayor Edwards asked the council to surplus a 2015 Chevrolet Tahoe VIN# 1GNSK3KC6FR583651,

Keith Higginbotham made a motion to surplus the vehicle 2nd by Josie Reed, All Council Members present voted in favor and the motion carried.
