

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

As part of the American Rescue Plan, The City of Centerton will receive 3.3 million over the next two years from the federal government. The U.S. Department of Treasury launched the relief to be allocated to four key areas, one of which is public health and economic recovery.

Organizations should apply if they can demonstrate that their activities support the public health response, or if they have experienced economic harm from the pandemic and that the funds, they distribute respond to that harm in ways that are related and reasonably proportional.

The City of Centerton will accept Formal Requests of Proposals until March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, at which time the Centerton City Council will review the proposals at the March 8<sup>th</sup> City Council Meeting.
