

**CITY OF CENTERTON
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 8, 2010**

The city council was called to order by Mayor, Bobbie Griffith. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the prayer was offered by Tommy Laird. Those Present and answering roll call were Mayor Bobbie Griffith, Kathy Huber, Patricia Thornhill, Josie Reed, Tommy Laird and Randy Thomas. Keith Higginbotham was absent while working for the 2010 Census. Those present and not answering role call were Jan Dolan, Todd Wright, Brian Rabal, Howard Slinkard, Andrew Huntsinger, Lorene Burns, Lance Johnson, Robert Coffelt and Jeff Coffelt. Bert Johnson was absent as a Department Head.

- (1) **Council Minutes-** Patricia Thornhill made a motion to adopt the minutes from the May 11, 2010 council meeting with a 2nd from Kathy Huber. All members present voted in favor and the motion carried.

- (2) **Planning and Water & Sewer Minutes-** Kathy Huber made a motion to acknowledge receipt of the April 27, 2010 planning minutes and the April Water & Sewer minutes with a 2nd from Randy Thomas. All members present voted in favor and the motion carried.

- (3) **City and Court Financials-** Patricia Thornhill made a motion to accept the May, 2010 City and Court financials with a 2nd from Kathy Huber. All members voted in favor and the motion carried.

- (4) **Ordinance 2010-11- AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PURCHASE, POSSESSION, SALE AND OFFERING FOR SALE THE SYNTHETIC CANNIBINOID, KNOWN AS “SPICE” OR “K-2”: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.** Police Chief Lance Johnson addressed the council and explained that this ordinance was the same as the one being passed by other cities. He stated that it is the exact same resolution as Springdale’s. He stated that the name will probably change, so the chemical breakdowns are listed in the resolution. Patricia Thornhill made a motion to read the ordinance by title only with a 2nd from Randy Thomas. All council members voted in favor and the motion carried. Andrew read the ordinance by title only. Kathy Huber made a motion to suspend the rule requiring the reading of the ordinance 3 times with a 2nd from Tommy Laird. All council members voted in favor and the motion carried.
